Shelter Box is an international relief charity. It provides emergency shelter and aid items to families around the world who have lost their homes to disaster or conflict. The first distribution of 143 Shelter Boxes was sent to victims of the 2001 Gujarat India earthquake. Our Rotary district 7890 is being recognized as one of the top 20 all time Rotary district supporters of Shelter Box USA.
