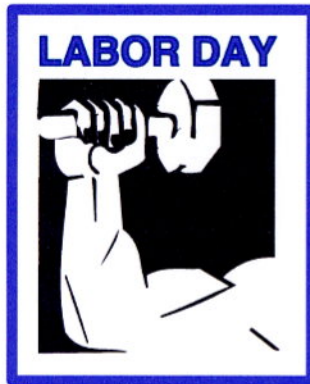

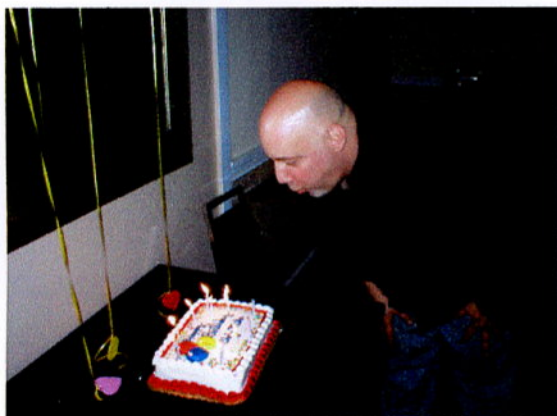

### Happy Birthday!



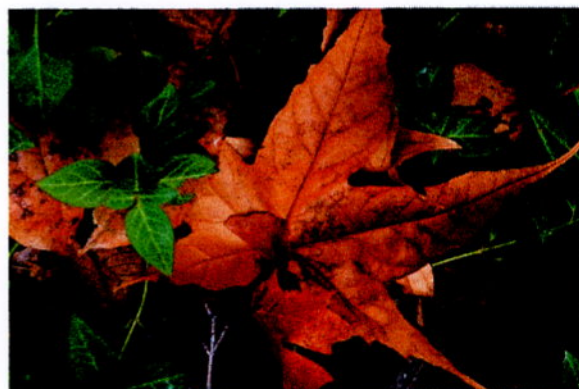
August 28, we sang Happy Birthday to our chef, Michael Mosera, and he obliged us by blowing out the candles on his cake!
